### Fireplace Pilot Lighting Procedure

If you had turned off your gas fireplace pilot light for the season and need to get it turned back on now, and aren't sure how it's done, here are simple instructions taken directly from your original fireplace manual:

**LIGHTING PILOT:** Depress and turn gas control knob counter clockwise to pilot position. Depress fully and hold pilot gas knob. Depress piezo igniter as many times as needed to ignite pilot. Keep knob fully depressed for a few seconds. Release and check that pilot continues to burn.

**TURN PILOT OFF:** Depress and turn gas control knob clockwise to "OFF" position.
