### Annual Dog Registrations - Due in January

It is time once again to register your dogs with the Association. ### Holiday Decorations and Lighting Rules

This is just a reminder that the Rules & Regulations provide that temporary holiday lighting and decor may only be displayed up to 30 days prior to the holiday, and must be removed within 15 days of the actual holiday. We are using **January 1** as the holiday date, meaning all temporary holiday lighting and decor needs to be removed by **Wednesday, January 16, 2019**. Thank you for your attention to this important rule to keep our community looking great!

### Snow & Ice - Be Cautious

With winter weather finally here, please use reasonable caution as you drive and walk through the community during periods of snow and ice. Our Maintenance team and snow removal contractor do their best to keep the drives and sidewalks reasonably clear of snow and ice, but the surfaces can never be completely cleared so some may remain slick.
