### Annual Dog Registrations - Due in January 2020

It is time once again to register your dogs with the Association. If the Association is aware that you have a dog residing in your Unit, you will soon be receiving a separate letter with the required Pet Registration form. Please complete the form and deliver it to the Management office by February 1, 2020. The Association will be following its Pet Policy and supporting governing documents to enforce compliance with this requirement. Please register your dog early to avoid the \$100.00 late registration fee and any fines that may be levied for noncompliance.

This is a reminder that the Rules & Regulations provide that temporary holiday lighting and decor may only be displayed up to 30 days prior to the holiday, and must be removed within 15 days of the actual holiday.
