Due to COVID-19 related concerns and in an effort to increase social distancing, the Peloton's twice monthly Movie Nights have been cancelled effective immediately, and until further notice. We greatly appreciate your patience and understanding as we work to best address the COVID-19 threat and its impact upon the community.

Exterior Defect Repairs Begin Next Month - Construction Activity Pending

As you know, Phase I of the exterior defect repair work will begin late next month, on Building D. As we reported last week, construction trailers, containers, dumpsters and porta-lets will be placed on site in preparation for this work. The delivery and placement of this equipment will occur beginning and continue through next week. Management has worked with the general contractor (AGS Construction) to place this equipment as needed to minimize resident and commercial business impact. Specifically, for this Phase of work a contractor office trailer will be parked in the southeast corner parking lot at the east end of Bldg D, and the remaining equipment will be stored just east of the Bldg C&D breezeway in parking spaces. As work continues through each Phase, equipment will be moved to the area being worked on. We appreciate your patience through this necessary work process.

Parking Reminders

The parking above ground in the courtyard area is for Guests only, and overnight parking in this area is for registered Guests only. Residents of The Peloton are not allowed to park above ground overnight. You may obtain a Parking Permit for overnight parking for your Guest from the Management office, or on the Association website.
