New Move-In/Move-Out Protocol

Additional Hand Sanitizer Product to be Installed Monday, March 23, 2020

We have leveraged our relationship with our carpet cleaning vendor to obtain additional hand sanitizer stations in the condominium building common areas, through a hand sanitizer service that will begin this coming Monday, March 23, 2020. Cintas will install these additional stations at locations we will direct them to. This is a month to month service which can be cancelled at an appropriate point in the future.

As we all use more hand sanitizer and wipes, please remember to NOT flush any wipes down the toilet. This applies to "flushable wipes" too! Especially at this time, we need to work together to mitigate possible maintenance items, as response times for anything needing to be repaired will likely be longer than usual.
